Ed Landgraf is the founder and Chairman of the Coastal And Marine Operators (CAMO) industry group where he serves as Director of Marine Safety for Texas 811 where he also leads MarineSafe811.

With more than 35 years of experience in the oil and gas industry, Ed has become a nationally recognized authority on marine and coastal operations, infrastructure protection, and damage prevention.

A native of Oklahoma and graduate of Oklahoma State University, Ed began his career in the oil industry across Texas, New Mexico, and Colorado before dedicating over three decades to the Gulf of America. His work includes developing national initiatives and completing special international assignments in New Zealand and Australia. Throughout his tenure, Ed has championed programs focused on Shell's infrastructure protection, non-technical risk, public safety, process safety, and coastal rehabilitation. Ed also served on Shell's Wetlands Advisory Team.

Ed's leadership extends to founding CAMO in 2009 and MarineSafe811 in 2023 – two national initiatives that now unite more than 35 companies, NGOs, and government agencies to advance marine infrastructure safety, damage prevention, environmental protection, asset integrity, and personnel safety through the design and implementation of new solutions.

Ed is widely recognized as an expert witness on marine pipeline issues and has testified before the United States Congress as a subject matter expert.
