

New Features to DamagePreventionPortal

Pelican released updates on November 16 that included a number of bug fixes for start date calculations along with some much-awaited changes.

The 10-day restriction on posting to past-due tickets was lifted. A member can now post on a ticket until the ticket is expired or work is completed. We anticipate the next release to include the ability to post up to the ticket expiation even if the work has been completed. In addition to being able to close out tickets all the way to expiration, old/expired tickets have been removed from the unassigned category of Positive Response. In fact, you will find a few additions to the Response Code Categories in Positive Response. See what's new in the short video below:



These are dig tickets that still require a response.


MISS DIG 811 Annual Meeting 2023

Why Your Area of Interest (AOI) Is Important

One subject I always discuss when I'm visiting a MISS DIG 811 municipal member, or for that matter, any facility owner/operator, is their AOI, or Area of Interest. I typically will show a member (if



they're not already aware) how to access their AOI, and then discuss various philosophies that different members have regarding their AOI.

A member's Area of Interest isn't a listing of their favorite hobbies on a dating profile. Instead, it's where they've requested to be notified when a MISS DIG 811 ticket is placed, via the use of "shape" files. A member shares with MISS DIG 811's Member Support department where they want to be notified on the MISS DIG 811 map, and when an excavator's drawn polygon or shape overlaps the member's shape, that member receives the dig notice or ticket. It's as simple as that.

Enhancements to OneCallAccess Ticket Sharing are currently being tested. The new Ticket Sharing feature allows users to share their tickets with designated users. Tickets that are shared can be viewed in the recipient's OneCallAccess History and Positive Response. Basic and External Plus users of the OneCallAccess ticket entry platform may share their tickets or be the recipient of shared tickets.

Users who want to share their tickets will initiate sharing by creating a share link request that is sent to selected users. Invitations must be accepted for Ticket Sharing to become active. Upon acceptance of share request, a share link is created.



The requester determines what level of access to provide the recipient(s), READ, or READ/WRITE. Recipients with READ/WRITE access can view and perform actions on shared tickets. The originator also determines the beginning and ending dates for sharing, and if the recipients should have access to all tickets or those created after sharing begins.

This update does NOT allow users to choose which tickets to share. Tickets are shared based on a chosen time frame. This phase of Ticket Sharing is ideal for coworkers from the same company, including field crews who check Positive Response prior to digging.

Users of the OneCallAccess ticket entry platform and Members will be notified when the Ticket Sharing enhancement is available. Additional Ticket Sharing forums will be held in January.
