Pelican Updates

OneCallAccess (OCA) updates are expected in the first week of January. Watch for a message on the home page of your OCA account when the update occurs. A full list of changes will be displayed on the Excavation Pro's Reference Material page on the MISS DIG 811 website at that time as well. Some of the changes include:

Blank Street Field	The Update will prevent tickets with blank fields to be submitted.
Copy Action	The copy action makes it convenient to duplicate ticket information for the purpose of creating a new ticket. Since the tickets do not need to be related to the same job to use the copy action, the polygon will no longer be copied onto the new ticket.
Onsite Contact Company Information	The onsite contact company was resetting when a ticket was being retransmitted. After the update, the system will duplicate the Onsite Contact Company Info from the original ticket to the new version.
User Settings	The update will fix a bug that was preventing the user settings from being prepopulated onto a ticket.
