When a project requires more than one ticket, take the opportunity to schedule your work in stages. Scheduling work to reflect when the digging will begin instead of choosing the same *Work to Begin Date* provides the facility owners adequate time to respond to your request.

Previous and New Scope of Works

This Ticket Comparison Guide is to help our users navigate the current S-O-W change. The maximum linear feet allowed on a dig ticket will be up to 1,320 linear feet in any direction in an urban area and 2,640 linear feet in any direction in a rural area.

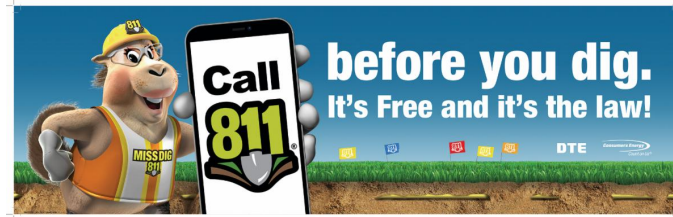
