-Ticket Transmission Formats-

With a change like this members can expect delivery changes that will affect the way they receive tickets. Below is some helpful information on the upcoming changes. Check back often as new resources will be added weekly.

GML Attachment	Newer ticket management systems	Drawn dig site only in Geographical Markup Language; supplemental, not the ticket	No
GIF Attachment	Newer ticket management systems	Image of drawn dig site overlayed on a base map (e.g., Google); supplemental, not the ticket	Yes
АРІ	Primarily for ticket management systems but can also be used to inject tickets into another program or software	Application programming interface that allows two applications to talk to each other without human interaction (e.g., NotificationAcess to Utilisync or Utilisphere)	No

With the implementation of the new Pelican platform, ticket transmission format options will be expanding. This change will go into effect on December 15, 2021. A ticket is transmitted to a facility owner/operator member when a contractor's work location polygon overlaps the facility location information in a member code's database, which is comprised of polygons. The following formats may be mixed and matched (e.g., you may choose a TXT format of the ticket in the email body and

receive the GIF attachment of the dig site):

- They have a safety management system in place, <u>MISS DIG 811 Field Basics or Safe Excavation Practices</u> qualifies as your companies safety management system, it is available free live or online
- Workers must continue training and recertify yearly
- Workers have stop-work authority if they think something isn't right
- They agree to follow <u>CGA Best Practices, specifically chapter 5</u>, and <u>Michigan PA -</u>

 - Expedited Permit Process- Municipalities that are also MISS DIG 811 Gold Shovel Standard participants can provide an expedited permitting process and right of way review process for MISS DIG 811 Gold Shovel Standard Facility Owner/Operators and Excavators.
